Guidelines For The Use of Space Heaters

The University of South Alabama recognizes that individuals have different levels of comfort associated with temperature and heat. We understand that some areas are more difficult to heat than others. In areas where this problem exists the temporary use of electric space heaters may be permitted if the following guidelines are followed:

- x Fuelpowered (propanet erosene)spaceheaters are not permitted. Space eaters must not takemore than 10 volts.
- x Any space heaters used must be(UbderwritersLaboratory)approved.
- x Approved spaceheatersmustbefan driven. Space heatewisth heatedcoils are not permitted.
- x Space heaters shall heave thermostat that shutter when a certain temperature is reached.
- x Space heaters shall heave tip-overshutdown feature.
- x Spaceheatersmustbeplugged into avall receptacle. Extension corslsall not beused.
- x Spaceheaterswith wattagecontrolsshall not besetabove1 00 watts.
- x Spaceheaterswithout manual controls hall not bemore than 100 watts.
- x Spaceheatersmustalwaysbeturned offand unplugged when the arbeaing heated is not ccupied.
- x Space heaters must be kept at least 3 feet from any combustible materials.
- x Nothingshallbeplaced on top ospaceheaters.
- x Hot plates and to astee vensshould nevebeused for spaceheating.
- x Space heaterasre not allowed in labs where chemicals are used.
